## IMPORTANT NOTICES

1. The election and rejection of members rests with the relevant Regional Committee. Your membership will be considered provisional until approved by the Regional Committee.
2. VAT invoices and receipts are not normally issued. If you require one please contact NODA Headquarters at the address overleaf.
3. The Association is pleased to report that recent revisions to the **Gift Aid Scheme** permit the Association to reclaim the tax paid by Individual Members on their subscriptions and very much hopes that you will feel able to assist the Association in this way.

In order to be able to reclaim the tax, the Association needs a formal but simple one-off declaration from Individual Members that they wish their subscriptions to be treated as donations under the Gift Aid Scheme and such a declaration is therefore set out overleaf.

The Association is required to inform members that in order to comply with the terms of the Scheme they must pay each year sufficient UK income tax on their salary, pension, savings interest or other income to cover the tax to be reclaimed on the subscription and all other payments under Gift Aid in each income tax year. This declaration will cover all your subscription renewal payments for as long as you remain a member of the Association. However, should you cease to be a UK taxpayer, please let the Association know so that it does not seek to reclaim any further tax. If for any reason you are not sure about your tax position you should not sign the declaration overleaf or ask your local tax office for leaflet IR113 *Gift Aid*.

Please note that if you pay tax at the higher rate you can claim further tax relief in your Self Assessment tax return.

4. The National Operatic and Dramatic Association is registered with the Data Protection Commissioner and abides by the Data Protection Act 1998. Members' names, addresses and telephone numbers may be held on computer files and circulated amongst the membership.
